Update 13 Rural Coordinated Public Transit-Human Services Transportation Plans (Coordinated Plans):

1. Assess available transportation services
2. Assess transportation needs for individuals with disabilities & seniors
3. Identify strategies, activities, and/or projects to address identified gaps and opportunities for efficiencies
4. Prioritize implementation of actions based on resources and time
