Regional Transportation Planning Agencies

Dear Executive Directors:

At the June 25, 2012, Rural Counties Task Force (RCTF) meeting a consensus was reached with regard to the \$36,815 in remaining unallocated Rural Planning Assistance (RPA) funds. The RPA funds were identified as available for reallocation as a result of forfeiture by agencies which exceeded the maximum 25 percent carryover as specified in Section 4.03 of the 2011 Regional Planning Handbook. The consensus of the RCTF was to divide the funds amongst all 26 Regional Transportation Planning Agencies (RTPAs).

RTPAs have been reallocated funds using the same allocation formula used to allocate the RPA funds awarded each year. See attached table for each agency's reallocated amounts from Fiscal Year (FY) 2010–11 as well as the FY 2012–13 allocations available for programming:

Agencies that wish to utilize these funds must amend them into their FY 2012–13 Overall Work Program (OWP) and Overall Work Program Agreement (OWPA) **by May 1, 2013**. Failure to amend the funds in to the FY 2012–13 OWP/OWPA will result in the funds being forfeited and held for a future reallocation.
